* Loved the fact that we reused and recycled something old and turned it into something useful - we are environmental warriors.

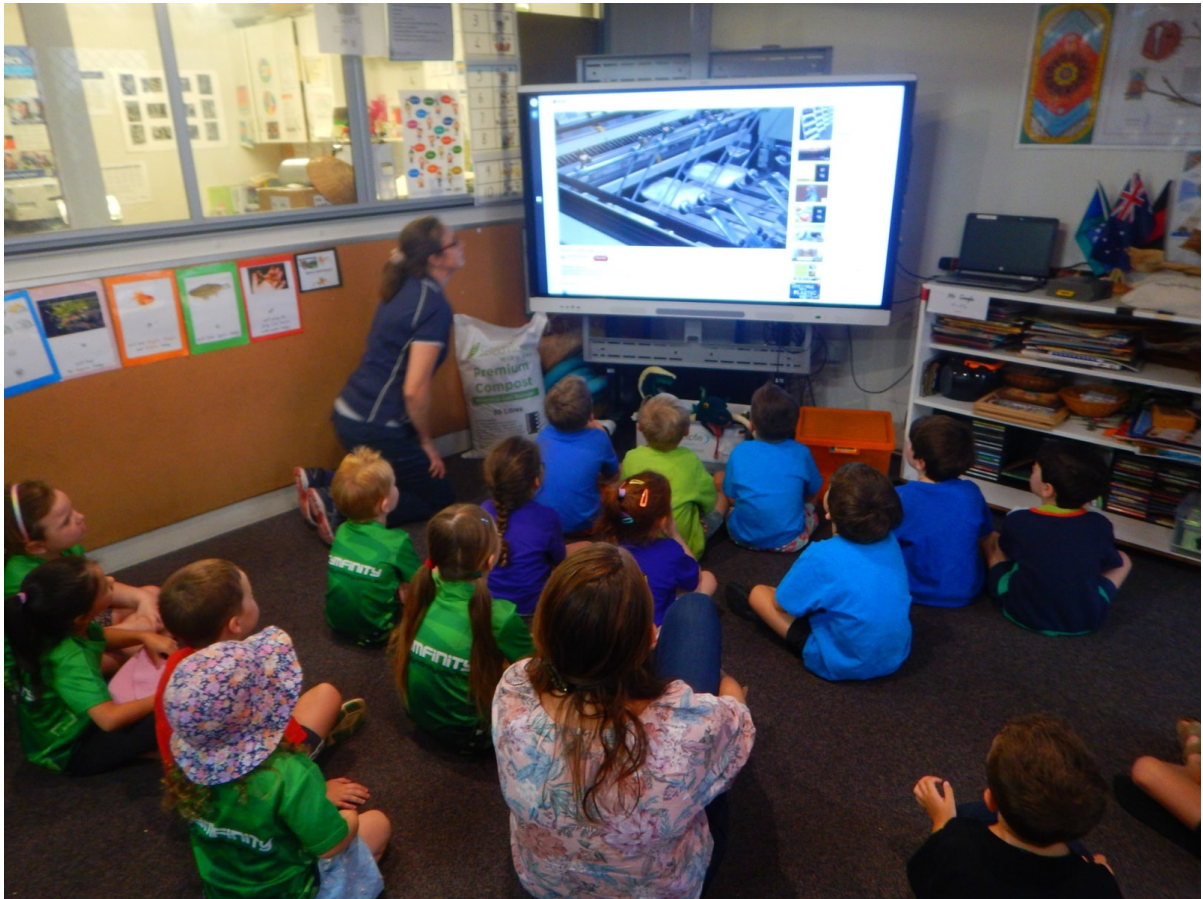
* Loved the fact that we now have our very own bag to use forever and forever

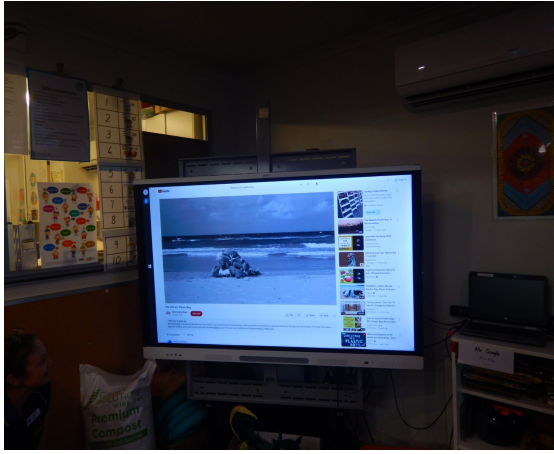
* Loved watching the Boomerang Bags video of : "The life of a plastic bag" again.

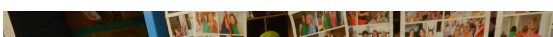


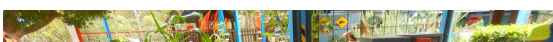
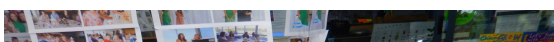














Learning tags:
